

72 Hour Loss Notification

Beginning with crop year 2015 and future year's producers participating in the Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (NAP) may be required to report losses within 72 hours. For hand-harvested crops and other crops as determined by FSA, at least 1 producer having a share in the unit **must** notify FSA of damage or loss through the administrative County Office for the unit within 72 hours of the date damage or loss first becomes apparent.
